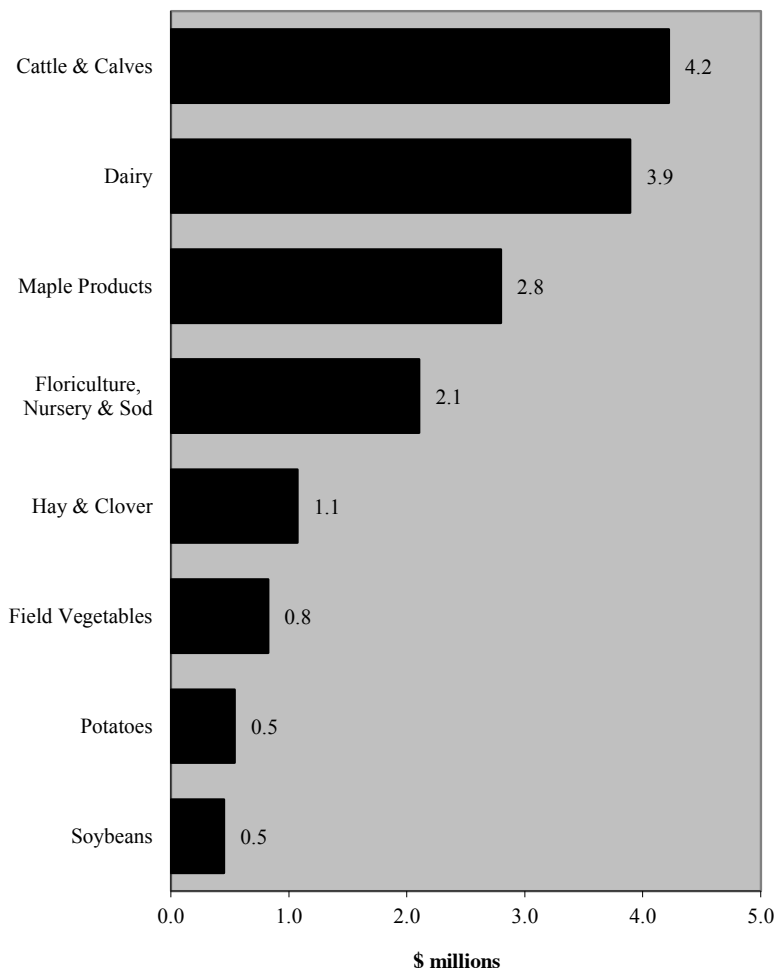

Farm Cash Receipts for Main Commodities, Algoma, 2013 (Total = \$21.7million)

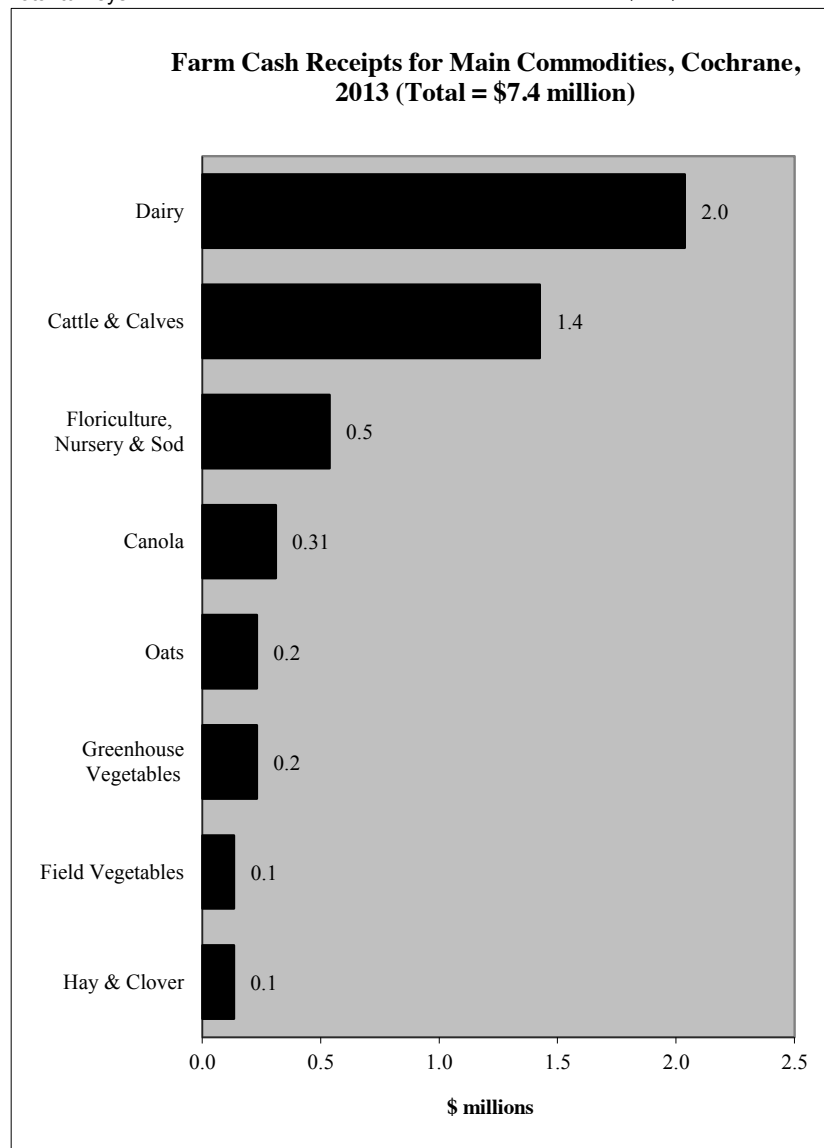
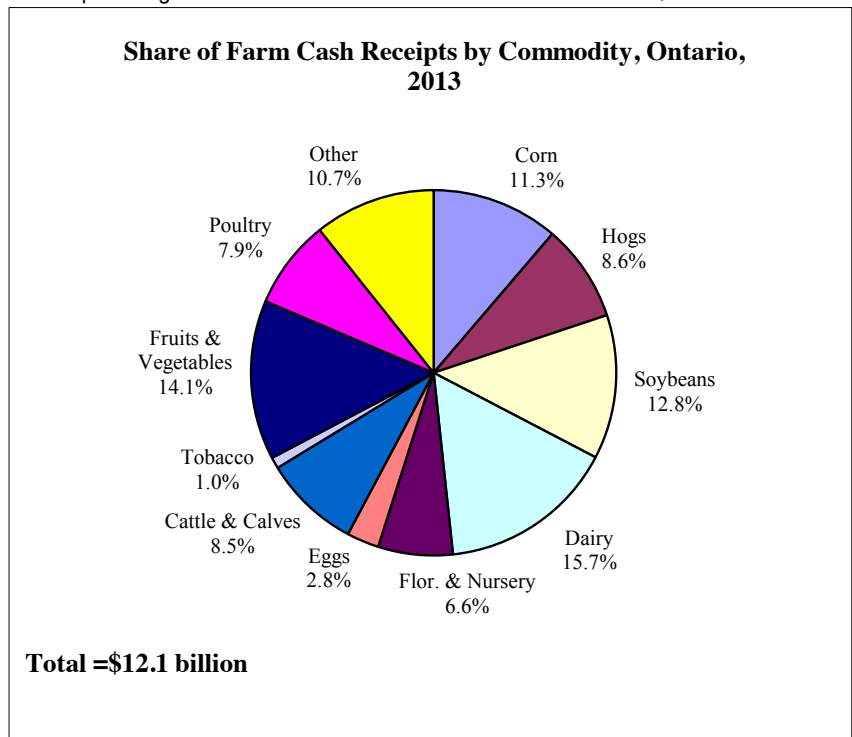
